



MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Service Requirements

- What is a Service Hour?
 - Unpaid help that benefits another group of people with the intent to service others.
- What a Service Hour is NOT
 - Church Activities
 - Getting paid to mow your neighbor's lawn
 - Helping your family clean the garage

Service Requirements

- **Candidate Quarter** Requirements
 - 7 total service hours
 - 5 MUST be contributed to a BAP sponsored event
 - 2 can be contributed to BAP or another organization
 - Included in the service hours has to be one of the mandatory events
 - Oct 24th UWAB Stadium Fundraiser
 - Date TBD KZOK Radio-thon

Service Requirements

- **Annual Requirements**
 - 8 in addition to candidate quarter
 - **15 Total Service Hours**
 - only 5 total hours can be contributed from Non-BAP events
- Keep track of non-BAP hours and submit them via the link on the BAP website (lower righthand side under TOOLS)

No Show Policy

- If you sign up for an event and later realize you cannot attend that event, you **MUST** cancel a **minimum of 24 hours** in advance.
 - **1st Offense:** Warning and 1 additional service hour added to total yearly requirement
 - **2nd Offense:** 5 additional service hours added to total yearly requirement
 - **3rd Offense:** Dropped from membership

 - BAP meetings and other informative, business related meetings
- What a Professional Hour is NOT
 - Recruiting Events

Professional Requirements

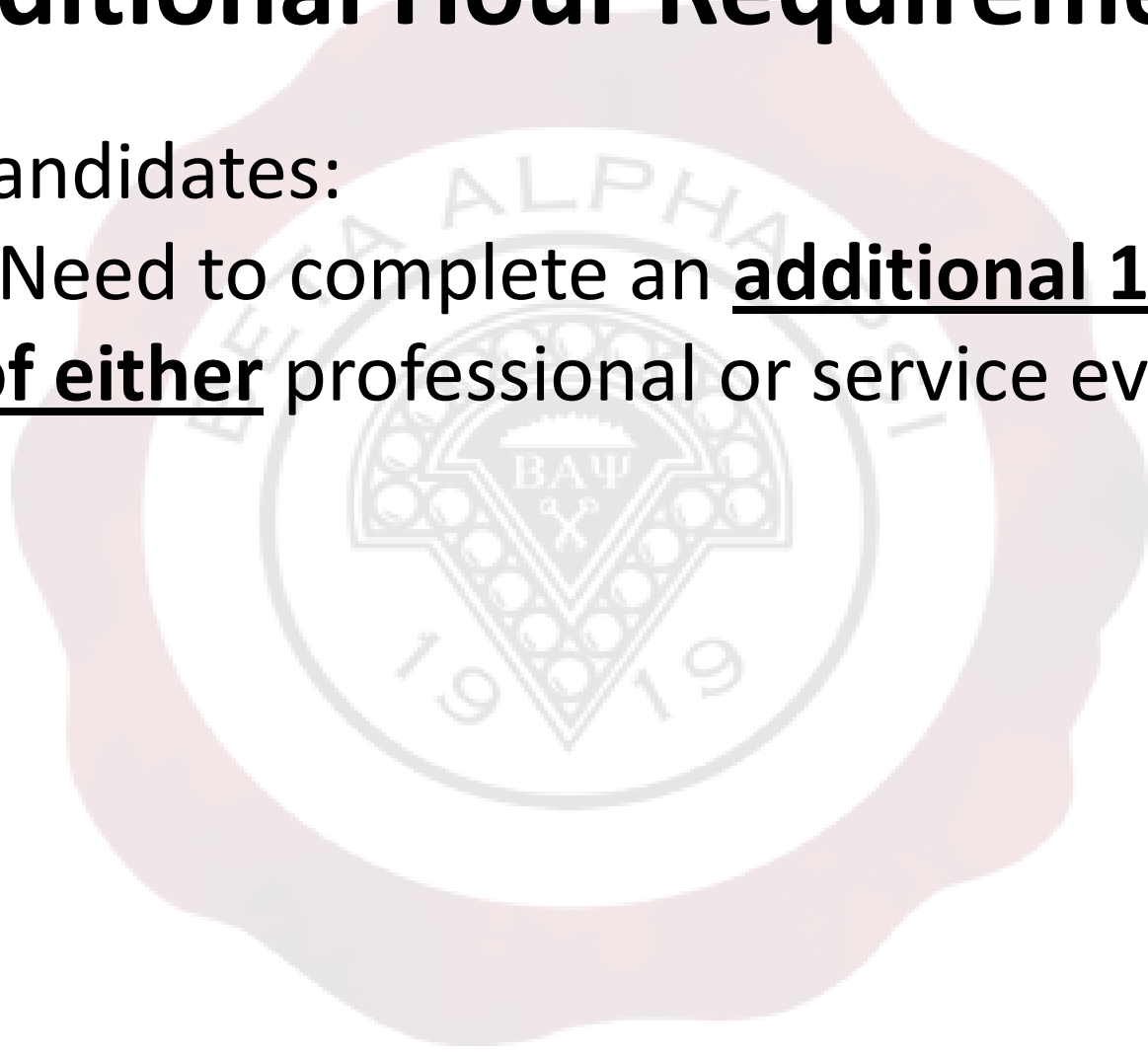
- Candidate Quarter
 - 8 Total Professional Hours
 - 7 MUST be BAP meetings
 - 1 CAN be from another organization (check with VP of Membership)
 - CISB Students: Contact VP of Membership

Professional Requirements

- Annual Hour Requirements
 - 3 in addition to candidate quarter
 - **10 Total Professional Hours**
 - Only 5 total hours can be contributed from Non-BAP events

Additional Hour Requirements

- Fall Candidates:
 - Need to complete an **additional 10 hours of either** professional or service events



Total Hour Requirements

- Candidate Quarter

- 7 Service hours

- 5 must be BAP sponsored

- 8 Professional Hours

- 7 must be BAP meetings

- **Total: 15 hours**

- Annually

- 15 Service hours

- 15 Professional Hours

- 10 Additional Hours

- Service and/or Professional

- ONLY 5 Service and 5

- Professional Non-BAP

- hours can be contributed

- to your total hours

- **Total: 40 hours**

Meeting Requirements

- Arrive 10-15 minutes early to ensure your hours are properly recorded
- Attire: Business casual clothing

Academic Requirement

- Junior standing (have taken, or currently enrolled in a 300-level accounting class)
- 3.1 Overall GPA in upper level courses of your major

AND

- 3.1 Cumulative GPA

OR

- 3.25 for last 45-quarter credits

Additional Requirements


- Financial Contribution
 - \$55 pledge fee
 - \$40 quarterly dues
 - Fall Quarter Total: \$95
- Due Date
 - October 16th, 2008
 - Pay dues before Thursday meetings or in Balmer Commons at the BAP table on M-F from 11am-2pm
 - You must turn in your application **with** your dues in order for us to accept payment
